2019 Outcome Measures

95%

Ninety five percent of children served by CASA received one (1) or more services advocated for by CASA.



96% of children served by CASA had their medical needs met or when there were outstanding needs, an appropriate party was notified.

93%

93% of children assigned to CASA who required mental health treatment received the services or the appropriate party was notified.



98%

CASA verified that 98% of children served were living in safe placements or if considered unsafe, the appropriate parties were notified.



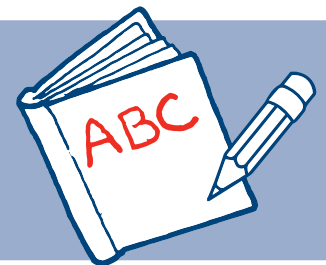
99% of children served by CASA were found to be living in the appropriate level of care, or when CASA noted concerns, the appropriate party was notified.

92% of children assigned to CASA who were in need of an IEP, 504 accommodation plan or RTI received the necessary services or the appropriate parties were notified.



94% of children assigned to CASA attended school at least 90% of the time or obstacles preventing attendance were identified and the appropriate parties were notified.
